

REPORT ON THE SECOND VOLUNTEER HEALTH CAMP OF EK EK PAILA

Nuwakot



Introduction

In June 2015, Ek Ek Paila organized its second health camp in Bhadrutar, Nuwakot district, to serve earthquake victims. This time, the team comprised nearly **50 members**, making it a larger group than before. For the first time, the team also included specialists such as psychologists, nutritionists, and counselors, thereby broadening the scope of services provided.

Objective

The camp was aimed at extending medical services, psychological support, and nutrition counseling to communities severely affected by the earthquake.

Services Provided

Following a swift setup, the team successfully served **560 patients** in total:

Eye Care - 239 patients examined by Dr. Suman Thapa and team

10 cataract cases referred

90 spectacles distributed

Dental Care – 150 patients treated by Dr. Neil Pande, Dr. Bhupesh

Shakya, and Dr. Luna Shrestha

80 referrals made

Gynecology - 60 patients treated by Dr. Sapana Vaidya

10 uterine prolapse cases

3 referrals for surgery

8 pregnancy tests (1 positive)

1 polyp case

Medicine-1 (Dr. Sudhamshu KC) – 65 patients

Hypertension: 3

Blood sugar tests: 5

Medicine-2 (Dr. Subodh Dhakal) – 70 patients

Medicine-3 (Dr. Jyotindra Sharma) – 35 patients

Osteoarthritis: 5 cases
