



Report on the 4th Health Camp

Introduction

- ▶ In August 2015, Ek Ek Paila organized its fourth health camp in Shyapru, Rasuwa District, an area severely affected by the earthquake. With logistical support from the Nepalese Army, the medical team was transported to the site via army helicopter.
- ▶ The return journey was particularly difficult due to continuous heavy rainfall.

Services Provided

- ▶ The camp successfully conducted 455 medical check-ups for 240 patients. The distribution of services:
 - ▶ Eye care: 140 check-ups
 - ▶ ENT (Ear, Nose, Throat): 61 check-ups
 - ▶ General medicine: 172 check-ups
 - ▶ Radiology: 82 procedures

Living Conditions

- ▶ During the camp, accommodations for the medical team were arranged by the patients themselves, who hosted the team in temporary shelters with tin roofs. This reflected the resilience and generosity of the local community.

Conclusion

- ▶ The Fourth Health Camp in Rasuwa was a testament to Ek Ek Paila's dedication to delivering healthcare in crisis-hit and remote areas. Despite extreme weather conditions and post-earthquake hardships, the camp succeeded in providing essential medical services, strengthening the Foundation's commitment to humanitarian service.
