



REPORT ON THE 5TH HEALTH CAMP

MANANG DISTRICT | SEPTEMBER 2015 | EK EK PAILA

INTRODUCTION

- In September 2015, Ek Ek Paila organized its fifth free health service camp in Manang District. Shortly after departing from Kathmandu, the team encountered vehicle breakdowns, which delayed their journey. After approximately 13 hours of travel, they reached Besishahar in Lamjung. From there, the team navigated difficult road conditions to reach Manang and conducted the camp in the areas of Chame and Humde.

SERVICES PROVIDED

- During this camp, 956 patients received a total of 2,620 medical check-ups, tests, and treatments:
 - Eye care: 367 check-ups
 - Dental care: 305 check-ups
 - Dermatology: 179 check-ups
 - Gynecology: 302 check-ups
 - General medicine: 464 check-ups
 - Orthopedics: 280 check-ups
 - Radiology services: 194 procedures
 - Pathology services: 529 procedures

RETURN JOURNEY

- On their return journey, the team fortunately encountered a Nepalese Army helicopter, which allowed them to avoid the long, challenging, and difficult road travel back.



CONCLUSION

- The Fifth Health Camp in Manang showcased Ek Ek Paila's resilience and dedication. Despite vehicle breakdowns, long hours of travel, and harsh road conditions, the team successfully delivered comprehensive medical services to 956 patients across multiple specialties. The experience reinforced the Foundation's mission to extend healthcare access to Nepal's remote regions.
