# Camp Highlights

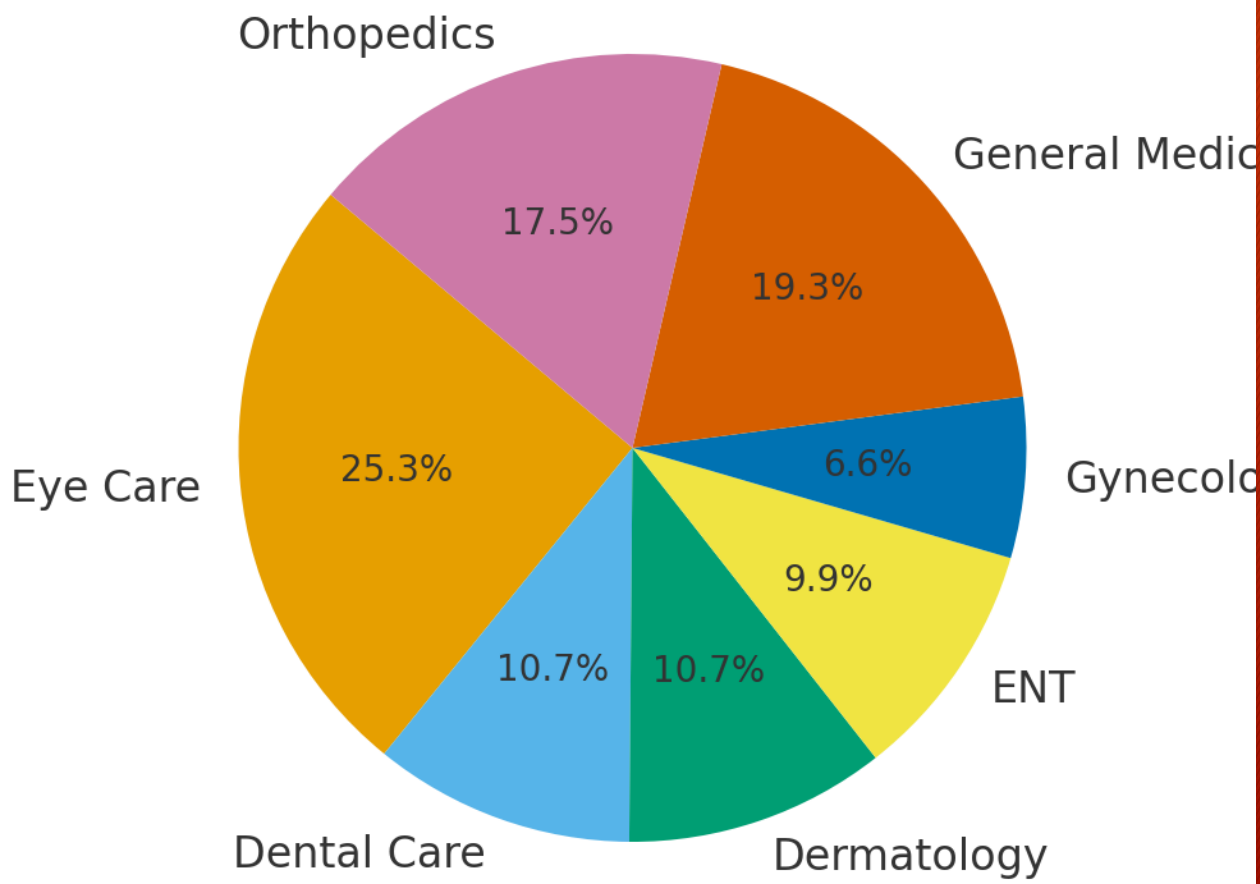
- • Total patients served: 674

- • Minor Surgeries: 74
- • Pathology Services: 83

- During the camp, a woman who had returned after treatment was found to have a fetal demise.
- • She was located promptly
- • Emergency medical care was provided
- This highlighted the importance of immediate medical follow-up and community trust.
