Braka Gumba, Halchok, Kathmandu (March 2016)

Introduction

- ♦ In March 2016, Ek Ek Paila conducted a free health service camp at Braka Gumba, Halchok, Kathmandu.
- ♦ A total of 315 patients benefited from the camp, receiving essential medical services.

Patient Services Overview

♦ 315 patients received a total of 1,275 medical check-ups, tests, and treatments.

Patients

- ♦ 220 check-ups were conducted to ensure better eye health.
- ♦ **Eye care:** 114 check-ups
- ♦ **Dental care:** 77 check-ups
- ♦ **Dermatology:** 22 check-ups
- ♦ **Gynecology:** 35 check-ups
- ♦ **General medicine:** 102 check-ups
- Orthopedics: 55 check-ups

- ♦ The Eleventh Health Camp at Braka Gumba, Halchok, Kathmandu provided vital healthcare services to 315 patients through 1,275 check-ups, tests, and treatments.
