# Introduction

- ◊ In March 2016, Ek Ek Paila conducted a free health service camp at Braka Gumba, Halchok, Kathmandu.
- ◊ A total of 315 patients benefited from the camp, receiving essential medical services.

# Patient Services Overview

- ◇ 315 patients received a total of 1,275 medical check-ups, tests, and treatments.

## Patients

- ◇ 220 check-ups were conducted to ensure better eye health.
- ◇ **Eye care:** 114 check-ups
- ◇ **Dental care:** 77 check-ups
- ◇ **Dermatology:** 22 check-ups
- ◇ **Gynecology:** 35 check-ups
- ◇ **General medicine:** 102 check-ups
- ◇ **Orthopedics:** 55 check-ups

- ◆ The Eleventh Health Camp at Braka Gumba, Halchok, Kathmandu provided vital healthcare services to 315 patients through 1,275 check-ups, tests, and treatments.
