- Female members faced anxiety & homesickness, but team reached safely

Camp Highlights

- • 874 patients received treatment
- • 2,979 check-ups/tests/treatments provided
- First time introducing tympanic membrane repair surgeries

Services Breakdown

- • Eye care: 465 check-ups
- • Dental care: 289 check-ups
- Dental extractions: 150 procedures
- Dermatology: 189 check-ups
- • ENT: 252 check-ups
- • Gynecology: 205 check-ups
- • General medicine: 591 check-ups
- • Orthopedics: 176 check-ups

Surgeries & Diagnostics

- 30 cataract surgeries
- • 23 ear surgeries
- • 185 radiology services
- • 424 pathology services
- Some patients from Kathmandu postponed surgeries
