

Report on the 19th Paila Health Camp Dho, Upper Dolpa

September 2019

Location & Preparation

- Dho, Upper Dolpa (3,900 meters above sea level)
- Team acclimatized by staying in Dunae three days prior
- Camp conducted at the local primary health center

Overview of Services

- • 930 patients served
- • 2,416 medical consultations provided

Breakdown of Services

- Eye care: 308 check-ups, including 40 cataract surgeries
- Dental care: 359 check-ups, including 58 extractions
- Dermatology: 101 check-ups
- ENT: 139 check-ups
- Gynecology: 207 check-ups
- General medicine: 519 check-ups
- Pediatrics: 173 check-ups
- Radiology: 166 procedures
- Pathology: 346 procedures

Key Findings

- Opportunistic screening revealed high prevalence of Hepatitis B infection
- • Suspected contributing factors:
- Cross-border interactions with Tibet
- - Cultural practices such as polygamy
